


- Allocated in FHDC Core Strategy March 2022

PHASE 1 TOWN CENTRE


PHASE 1B – Hilltop and Woodland Ridge

We are beginning tier 2 work:

- > Why now?
- Introducing JTP
- Prepare masterplan and design code
- Reflect previous comments from residents:
 - Traffic congestion and lorries on A20, particularly when M20 closed
 - Retain identity and character of Barrow Hill with a green buffer
 - Close Harringe Lane as a through route
